### How the Sports Premium Grant will be used during 2016/2017

We plan to continue to use the Sports Premium Grant to purchase specialist input to enhance and update our teaching of PE as well as investing in more appropriate resources. This year we will be utilising Soccer 2000's support to help support the targeting teaching of specific groups within each lesson/topic. Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will all benefit from one PE session per week led by Soccer 2000. Within this session the teachers will work alongside the coaches to differentiate and target specific teaching strategies to specific groups (i.e. more able/less able). We believe that this will help us further enhance the teaching of PE and firmly embed the high quality teaching and learning of PE into our curriculum.

#### Aims

- To improve and enhance targeted teaching and learning, especially for more able/less able children in PE.
- To continue to enhance the profile, delivery and standards in PE.
- To facilitate continued Professional Development for teachers through coaching and mentoring by Soccer 2000.
- To give teachers increased confidence and knowledge to plan for, teach, differentiate and assess groups of pupils in a range of PE curricular activities.

#### Activities

- We will continue with **three half day sessions of PE support per week** for the coming academic year to be provided by Soccer 2000.
- Each year group (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2) will be divided between the classes one morning or afternoon a week. Two Soccer 2000 coaches will deliver PE lessons in line with the requirements of the National Curriculum **with class**

**teachers present.** The continued aim of these sessions is to deliver high quality PE teaching and to provide high quality professional development for teachers.

- Coaches & teachers will also focus (together) on assessing the children's development and any intervention needs.

### **Cost Breakdown**

- Soccer 2000 - £8275
- Supply - £625 per year

- **Teachers more knowledgeable and confident in their ability to identify and support more able & less able children in PE**  
(*evidenced through informal lesson observations/appraisal interviews with Teachers*)
- **Through Soccer 2000's coaching and teachers support all children making gains in learning through appropriate PE teaching** (*evidenced through informal lesson observations and intervention records*)
